Augusta Weststar (AW139) helicopters it ordered which will be used to perform offshore transport missions supporting offshore oil and gas operations in the country.

Group Managing Director of Weststar, Tan Sri Syed Azman Syed Ibrahim said the company chartered one of the world's largest planes, the Antonov aircraft, to deliver the helicopters.
